



Directions

From the North

- Leave the M40 at Junction 12.
- Follow signs for Upton House - National Trust Property (seven miles from the motorway) off the A422.
- Turn in to the entrance to 'Upton House' adjacent to the National Trust car park.
- Continue straight down the private road sign posted to Home Farm Offices. Pull up to the electric wooden gate which will open automatically. Home Farm Offices and car park are straight in front.
- The Byre is located as displayed on the signboard.

From the South

- Leave the M40 at Junction 11.
- Head towards Banbury.
- Follow the A422 (signposted towards Stratford, you will go over several roundabouts).
- Continue for about 6 miles (going through the villages of Drayton and Wroxton). Stay on the A422 until you see signs to Upton House – National Trust Property.
- Turn in to the entrance to 'Upton House' adjacent to the National Trust car park.
- Continue straight down the private road sign posted to Home Farm Offices. Pull up to the electric wooden gate which will open automatically. Home Farm Offices and car park are straight in front.
- The Byre is located as displayed on the complex signboard and company sign on the front of the building adjacent to the door.

By rail

The nearest train station is Banbury, and the Byre is a 15 minute taxi ride away.
